- 1. On September 19th, 2025, I, Detective Lawson, was notified by Cpl. Lucente of a sexual abuse of a minor case that occurred at Oakdale Middle School.
2. I reviewed the report that was submitted to Child Protective Services. After reviewing the report, I learned that the victim was an student at Oakdale Middle School who was sexually abused by an aide in his class. The victim was identified as JUVENILE VICTIM 1. The suspect was identified as John McAleer (TARGET SUSPECT) (22 y/o male). It was later learned that John's title in the classroom was a Special Education Aide. It should also be noted that JUVENILE VICTIM 1 is diagnosed with autism and is a part of the "Learning For Life" class, which means he is a non-diploma-bound student. The classrooms that JUVENILE VICTIM 1 and John are in are referred to as the "L4L Classrooms" and are located right next to each other.
3. The reporting party (RP) was another special education aide in one of the L4L classes. She reported to Child Protective Services that she observed something suspicious on September 19th, 2025. She explained that JUVENILE VICTIM 1 usually goes to "specials" (electives) with John, along with two other students in the program. RP advised that she was not aware at the time, but the other two students were absent that day. RP reported that she returned to her classroom, next to JUVENILE VICTIM 1 and John's classroom, with the students that she brings to specials. RP observed that the lights were off and the door was closed in the other classroom, while the door was open in her classroom. RP also saw other students returning from their respective specials and tried to get into the other classroom. RP noted that the door was closed, locked, and the lights were out. She did not see anyone in the classroom through the glass window of that door. She told the children to wait for the teacher as she stood between the two classroom doors.
4. While standing there, RP noticed the door to the other classroom opened, and John exited. This was from the room where the door was locked, and the lights were out. RP noted that before John exited the room, several students tried getting into the classroom, as well as another aide identified as Aaron Dhane. John left the room and began talking to Aaron. RP was confused by the situation and looked into the classroom to see if anyone else was in there. When she looked inside, she saw JUVENILE VICTIM 1, who had his shirt tucked into his pants and was holding his crotch area. RP then noticed that JUVENILE VICTIM 1 had an erection. RP said that she tried checking on JUVENILE VICTIM 1 to see if he was ok, but JUVENILE VICTIM 1 brought both hands up to his cheeks, then bit his hand and ran to the corner as if he was embarrassed and tried to hide. RP was unsure how long John and JUVENILE VICTIM 1 were in the classroom alone with the doors locked and lights out. RP said that she later tried to talk to JUVENILE VICTIM 1, but it was too loud in the classroom, and he did not respond to her question.

5. RP then reported other incidents that raised her suspicion that John could possibly be abusing students. She said that last year she heard an inappropriate conversation between John and Aaron. RP explained that she heard John talk about another student's private parts and said that the student's penis was "so big" he "could trip over it". John then said that the student's penis was "big like a horse".

6. RP also noticed when she started with the school, spring semester 2025, John would take JUVENILE VICTIM 1 on music breaks. In the 2024/2025 school year, JUVENILE VICTIM 1 had a behavioral chart or "token reward system", John would regularly take JUVENILE VICTIM 1 on these music breaks. She explained that they happened every day, multiple times a day, and lasted approximately 10-15 minutes, and they would be in a separate room by themselves. RP explained when she started at the school, spring semester 2025, a substitute was in for John. This substitute took JUVENILE VICTIM 1 for the music break in the separate room. JUVENILE VICTIM 1 reportedly pulled his pants down upon entering the room with the substitute.

7. Later, during a conversation with RP, she also noted that she had seen John take pictures of students at the beginning of the 2025 school year. RP said that she also saw John show videos of students to other aides. RP said that the students were clothed but sometimes were doing strange poses. She recalled that John had shown her videos of students from his previous school, Carroll Manor Elementary. These videos were similar to the Oakdale Middle school videos where the students were not naked or doing any explicit action. However, RP noted that John would say things like a student, who was in the video, was a cutie. RP stated that she felt it was not an appropriate thing to say about a student in that manner.

8. Once at Oakdale Middle School, I made contact with JUVENILE VICTIM 1's mother. It's important to note that neither the school, CPS, nor law enforcement notified JV1's mother of the specific allegations. JV1's mother and father, asked for more information and were told to come to the school. When the CPS worker and I spoke to JV1's mother, she had not been informed about any further information other than that something had happened to JUVENILE VICTIM 1 at the school.

9. JV1's mother advised that she asked JUVENILE VICTIM 1 questions about what happened. Due to his diagnosis, JUVENILE VICTIM 1 is not fully capable of explaining things in full sentences. JV1's mother explained what JUVENILE VICTIM 1 had told her through his one-word responses. She learned that JUVENILE VICTIM 1 had gone into a room with John, and John turned the light off and closed the door. John then asked JUVENILE VICTIM 1 to touch his (John's) pants. JUVENILE VICTIM 1 showed his mom where he touched John, and started touching his penis, saying that John asked him to touch his penis. She then asked JUVENILE VICTIM 1 what John asked him to do, and JUVENILE VICTIM 1 responded, "faster and faster" while rubbing his penis, showing his mother what he was doing to John. JUVENILE VICTIM 1 said John was wearing black pants and green underwear. JV1's mother then asked JUVENILE VICTIM 1 if he had touched John's penis. She noted that she used the word "kunji," which means penis in their native language. JUVENILE VICTIM 1 confirmed that he touched John's "kunji".

10. JV1's mother noted that John has been an aide in JUVENILE VICTIM 1's class for the past year, maybe two years.

11. JV1's mother also advised that on Thursday, September 18th, JUVENILE VICTIM 1 came home with different underwear and pants on. She asked JUVENILE VICTIM 1 what happened, and he said that he got wet while playing with water. She did not inquire further and washed the clothes. JV1's mother stated that the school never called her to explain.

12. On September 22nd, 2025, I, Detective Lawson, and Kelsey Eitner (CPS) attended a forensic interview of JUVENILE VICTIM 1.

13. During the forensic interview, JUVENILE VICTIM 1 advised that he touched John's "kunji".

14. After the forensic interview, Kelsey and I made contact with a teacher of one of the Learning for Life classes (Herein referred to as Person Interviewed or "PI"). PI advised that she was not made aware of an incident that occurred on Friday, September 19th. Therefore, PI was not able to provide too many details surrounding the specific allegations regarding John and JUVENILE VICTIM 1. After the interview, PI contacted me and Kelsey and explained that she recalled something. She advised that on Thursday, September 18th, she was told by Ms. Brooks, another teacher in the Learning For Life program, that JUVENILE VICTIM 1 had "finished" in his pants and had to be changed. John later approached PI that same day and she explained that this was not appropriate to write in the daily logs. PI had told John that JUVENILE VICTIM's parents needed to be notified, but this would be Ms. Brooks job as she is JUVENILE VICTIM's case manager. As previously noted, JV1's mother was never contacted by John or any teacher/administrator at the school.

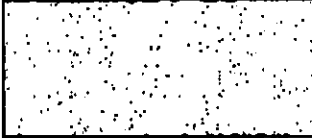

15. On September 26th, 2025, I, Detective Lawson, reviewed video surveillance from Oakdale Middle School. I observed video from September 19th, 2025, the day the reporting party observed John and JUVENILE VICTIM 1 alone, in a room together. The video shows John and JUVENILE VICTIM 1 entering room 104 at 0918 hours. The lights were already off in the room, and the door was open. JUVENILE VICTIM 1 enters the room first, then John follows, closing the door. John is observed to be wearing black pants and a dark colored shirt. At 0921, Aaron Dhane approaches the door to room 104 and looks inside. He does not enter. No other students enter the room at this time. At 0923, a student tries the door handle and opens the door, entering room 104. RP is then seen walking up to the opening, looking in, while John walks up to the door. At 0925, the lights for the room are turned on, but it is unknown who turned on the lights at this time.

16. On October 3rd, 2025, another student from the Learning For Life program was interviewed at the Child Advocacy Center. I, Detective Lawson and Kelsey Eitner (CPS) attended the forensic interview of JUVENILE VICTIM 2.

17. JUVENILE VICTIM 2 is diagnosed with autism and limited in his ability to communicate. JUVENILE VICTIM 2 identified John and stated that John had touched his (JUVENILE VICTIM 2's) penis and butt. JUVENILE VICTIM 2 advised that he was in a classroom when it happened. JUVENILE VICTIM 2 explained that the lights were off in the room. When asked if John told him to touch his (John's) privates, JUVENILE VICTIM 2 replied "Every private".

18. JUVENILE VICTIM 2 was asked what happened with his clothes, as he was repeating something to the effect that his clothes were ripped. JUVENILE VICTIM 2 replied that it was recorded on an iPad, belonging to John. JUVENILE VICTIM 2 described the iPad as having a purple case, and it was used to take pictures. JUVENILE VICTIM 2 then said that John showed him pictures of every private part, and that John had shown him his own private parts. JUVENILE VICTIM 2 later clarified that John was recording on his iPad, and that he took pictures of JUVENILE VICTIM 2's private parts.

19. After the interview I briefly spoke to JUVENILE VICTIM 2's mother, JV2's mother. I never mentioned John's name. I advised her the allegations were against an aide at the school. Later, JV2's mother emailed Kelsey and I the following thread, which was sent to Ms. Brooks, JUVENILE VICTIM 2's teacher:

- 20. Hi Ms Brooks - who is Mr John? JUVENILE VICTIM 2 seems to be quite upset about him. I don't know if it's the curriculum or not a good match?
21. Something is getting him really upset. With tears in his eyes.
22. Please help.
23. The email was sent on April 28th, 2025.
24. On 10/6/2025, I, Detective Lawson, and detectives from the Frederick County Sheriff's Office, conducted a search and seizure warrant at 3035 Basford Road, Frederick, MD. FCSO SWAT personnel conducted the entry and clearing of the residence.
25. It was learned that the suspect, John McAleer, had barricaded himself in his room.
26. While I was on scene, I made contact with Carol Waple, John's grandmother. Carol stated that John told her that he was placed on administrative leave last week regarding an altercation at Oakdale Middle School. She explained that she was unsure why and that John had not told her anything. Carol described John's demeanor as quieter than normal, and that she could tell something was going on. Carol later said that John had started telling her that he loved her more than he usually did. Carol said that she was unsure why he was saying this more, but noted it as abnormal.
27. Ultimately, it was learned that John had attempted suicide with a knife. John was ultimately transported to a trauma center in Washington, D.C. for treatment. After reviewing the SWAT personnel's BWC, I noted that John had said to the deputies, "I'm sorry to put you through this" as they were administering life-saving measures to assist him.
28. Upon entering the house and going to John's room, I observed large amounts of blood on the floor. The words "I'm sorry" were written in blood on the wall of his room, clearly visible as soon as you walk through the door.
29. A full search was conducted of John's room. The following items were collected: iPhone with a black case, Tan wallet with ID, AppleWatch, Blue iPhone, and a Notebook with a note inside
35. Upon entering the room and starting the search, I observed a notebook at the foot of John's bed. I opened the notebook, and the first page read:

39. It should be noted that 9/19/2025 is the date that John was placed on administrative leave from Oakdale Middle School regarding allegations made against him. These allegations are what led to the search warrant for the residence. John was notified by the school that he was being placed on leave for inappropriate behavior.

40. Important to note, the following statements were written on the first page: "I'm so sorry. I don't mean to hurt anyone. I never wanted to go out like this... I fear I have become the monster everyone thinks I am."

41. Further search of the room yielded several pictures drawn by students from the classes that John was an aide in. A brown wallet was then located. "JUVENILE VICTIM 3" was written on the top of the wallet. Inside was a student ID for JUVENILE VICTIM 3. JUVENILE VICTIM 3 was a student at Oakdale Middle School last year. He has moved on to Oakdale High School and does not have John as an aide anymore. It was expressed to me and CPS that John and JUVENILE VICTIM 3 were close. Further, the reporting party, noted that John had made inappropriate comments about the size of JUVENILE VICTIM 3's penis. Inside the wallet was JUVENILE VICTIM 3's student ID. On the back of JUVENILE VICTIM 3's ID was his home address. JUVENILE VICTIM 3 was interviewed at the Child Advocacy Center, but no disclosure was made as he could not relay anything more than one-word statements. Most of the time, he did not answer any questions.

42. Det. Patterson then found JUVENILE VICTIM 3's behavioral chart. These charts are used at Oakdale Middle School in the Learning for Life program as a way to reward the students with good behavior. RP noted that JUVENILE VICTIM 1 also had a behavioral chart at Oakdale Middle School, but this year it was not able to be located with the stack of the other students' charts.

43. Ultimately, we could not locate JUVENILE VICTIM 1 chart, but it should be noted that John's room was in complete disarray. Plenty of school-related documents, mostly pictures from students, and schedules were located in John's room.

44. While searching through the massive pile of dirty clothes, I located the shirt John was wearing on 9/19/25. This matches the video from Oakdale Middle School. I then located one singular pair of green underwear. I did not observe any distinct marks or stains on the underwear, but noted there were several other pairs of underwear of various colors. It should be noted that JUVENILE VICTIM 1 reported to his mother that John was wearing green underwear and black shorts. There were several pairs of black gym shorts in the room. None were distinguishable enough to match what was seen on the cameras.

45. The following items were seized from the garage:

46. iPad with blue and black case

47. iPad with black and blue case

48. It should be noted that JUVENILE VICTIM 2 reported in his Forensic Interview that John had recorded him with his iPad, which had a purple case. While the iPad that we located was determined to have a blue case, it was easy to understand how the color could be perceived as purple to a child. The iPads were previewed, and nothing of evidentiary value was located preliminarily. James provided the password to the iPad, which was 092770. James said that he uses the iPads for his business. However, the business had not been running since May, and one iPad was powered on.

49. John had recently, within the past month, told his father that he had been having problems with the children at school. He reportedly told his father that the kids have been driving him crazy, but Carol did not know more information. Carol then repeated that John had been acting differently, and he had been constantly telling her that he loved her.

50. In summary, John McAleer is an aide at Oakdale Middle School in the Learning for Life program. In this capacity, he is responsible for helping the teacher while supervising, sometimes alone, special needs students. Students in the Learning for Life program, including juvenile victims 1-3, are non-diploma-bound due to their various diagnosis attributing to their personal cognitive and physical impairments. As interviews of the juvenile victims were conducted, it was apparent that these individuals had a hard time relaying details surrounding what had happened to them. Despite these challenges, interviews and information learned from these interviews, as well as incidents reported by the victim's parents, corroborate similar instances of abuse by John McAleer. John has been an aide at Oakdale Middle School for approximately two to three years. Juvenile Victims 1 and 2 have been at Oakdale Middle School since the 2023-2024 school year. Juvenile Victim 1 has been assigned to John for at least the 2024/2025 school year and possibly the 2023/2024 school year. It is unknown if Juvenile Victim 2 has been assigned to John, but it is known via the interview that he has had direct contact with him.

51. JUVENILE VICTIM 1's parents noted severe changes in their child's habits. Specifically, more of a desire to masturbate or "Private Time" as he refers to it. They stated that this started a little over a year ago, and he began shutting the lights off in the room and closing the door when he had "Private Time". Additionally, it is known that JUVENILE VICTIM 1 had a behavioral chart where his reward would be individual music breaks that he would earn. These breaks were always supervised by John and would occur in a different room, where they would be alone within the school. In April of 2025, a substitute took JUVENILE VICTIM 1 to the "comfort room," and upon entering, JUVENILE VICTIM 1 turned the light off and pulled his pants down. This led to the reporting party believing something malicious was happening when she saw JUVENILE VICTIM 1 in a classroom alone with John. The lights were off, and JUVENILE VICTIM 1 had an erection.

52. Further, for JUVENILE VICTIM 2, the victim's mother noted an incident on April 28th, 2025. Although the victim could not relay exactly what happened due to his diagnosis, the mother noted that "Mr. John" had caused him to be extremely upset.

53. It should be noted that JUVENILE VICTIM 1 and JUVENILE VICTIM 2 are both 13 years old.

54. I, Detective Lawson, respectfully request a warrant for the following charges:

TO THE PERSON CHARGED:

1. This paper charges you with committing a crime.
2. If you have been arrested, you have the right to have a judicial officer decided whether you should be released from jail until trial.
3. If you have been served with a citation or summons directing you to appear before a judicial officer for a preliminary inquiry at a date and time designated or within five days of service if no time is designated, a judicial officer will advise you of your rights, the charges against you, and the penalties. The preliminary inquiry will be canceled if a lawyer has entered an appearance to represent you.
4. You have the right to have a lawyer.
5. A lawyer can be helpful to you by:
 - a. explaining the charges in this paper;
 - b. telling you the possible penalties;
 - c. helping you at trial;
 - d. helping you protect your constitutional rights; and,
 - e. helping you to get a fair penalty if convicted.
6. Even if you plan to plead guilty, a lawyer can be helpful.
7. If you are eligible, the Public Defender or a court- appointed attorney will represent you at any initial appearance before a judicial officer and at any proceeding under Rule 4-216.1 to review an order of a District Court Commissioner regarding pretrial release. If you want a lawyer for any further proceedings, including trial, but do not have the money to hire one, the Public Defender may provide a lawyer for you. The court clerk will tell you how to contact the Public Defender.
8. If you want a lawyer but you cannot get one and the Public Defender will not provide one for you, contact the court clerk as soon as possible.
9. **DO NOT WAIT UNTIL THE DATE OF YOUR TRIAL TO GET A LAWYER.** If you do not have a lawyer before the trial date, you may have to go to trial without one.
